Refugee services are characterized by an "Arrive and Thrive" mentality, seeking to overcome shortterm and long-term challenges in the resettlement and community integration process. We aim to provide best-in-class hospitality, services, and cultural education, using a strengths-based case management approach to understand and develop client goals. We believe that a thriving refugee community is predicated on community engagement, inviting stakeholders from across Kansas City to actively participate in the resettlement process and the advancement of refugee communities.

As a valued member of Della Lamb's new EMPOWER team, this position is focused on employment access, readiness, and retention. The Workforce Development Educator position is designed to respond to the varying job readiness and logistical needs of refugee clients as part of their employment search and placement process, including pre-employment and post-employment activities. The Workforce Development Educator will provide direct client services and coordinate case management activities with Della Lamb colleagues.

This position requires a commitment to teamwork, patience, adaptability, servant leadership, humility of spirit, a strong work ethic, and a commitment to learning and growth. As a new position at Della Lamb, this position will also require creativity with an entrepreneurial spirit. This position reports to the Workforce Development Manager but will actively work with staff members across Refugee Services to understand how to better serve clients and create pathways for community members to assist in community resettlement and integration.

Core responsibilities include, but may not be limited to, the following:

- · Lead job readiness classes, including content on pre-employment and post-employment activities.
- · Coordinate and oversee participation in the driving simulation program.
- Provide bus training, including training directly to clients and training volunteers to assist in bus training.
- · Coordinate interpretation for classes as necessary.
- · Coordinate completion of driver's education courses.
- · Coordinate completion of driver's tests with appropriate interpretation.
- · Provide training on Public Transit options.
- · Provide training on public transit options including navigating cellular transportation apps.
- · Provide cultural orientation on driving and insurance regulations.

• Provide feedback to Refugee Services team to identify opportunities for volunteers and community sponsorship groups to assist with transportation services.

· Document program enrollment and participation so that internal records can be updated.

· Embrace Della Lamb values of learning, integrity, gratitude, health, and togetherness.

· Perform other duties as assigned.
